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

The Beverly Hills West Septic Tank Phase Out construction work is complete with 445 homes connected to JEA's new gravity sewer system, their septic systems removed, and a new water system installed to replace the antiquated, failing system. The only remaining items to close out this project are approval of the final Record Drawings and execution of a final Change Order. This letter provides JEA with the items included in the final change order and the costs.

The final project change order is to cover required project changes that exceeded the total project contract amount. The change items include additional modifications to resident's properties to enable the connection to the new sewer system, additional curbing and roadway restoration, modifications to the existing stormwater system due to damage discovered during construction, and the need to reline select manholes due to high groundwater in the area. The project changes are summarized in table 1.
