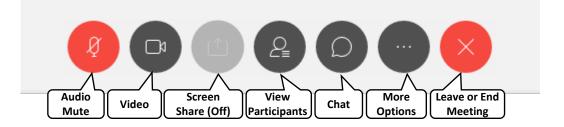

On 9/10/2020, JEA issued a letter to Wharton-Smith Inc. suspending all work under this contract. A copy of the letter is attached for reference. JEA has decided to cancel this capital project due to significant increase in total estimated project cost from approximately \$7,000,000.00 at conceptual study to approximately \$29,100,000.00 at 10% design. JEA has decided to perform additional engineering evaluation of methods to mitigate TTHMs and to initiate a new capital project (North Grid THM Mitigation Project) to manage TTHMs in the North Grid in a more cost effective manner.

In addition, the original project and contract were administered as a Design-Build project. This new project will be administered as a Design-Bid-Build project.

Wharton-Smith Inc. has invoiced \$423,885.96 of the original award amount, and JEA does not anticipate any further charges. #### **Background/Recommendations:**

Advertised on 06/21/19. Seven (7) prime companies attended the mandatory pre-proposal meeting held on 07/17/19. At proposal opening on 08/20/19, JEA received two (2) proposals. Due to the specialized nature of the ion exchange process, low participation was expected. During the solicitation process, JEA was asked to modify the minimum qualifications to increase participation. The minimum qualifications were modified, and the bid due date was extended. The changes made did not increase the competition. The public evaluation meeting was held on 09/19/19 and JEA deemed Wharton-Smith, Inc. most qualified to perform the work. A copy of the evaluation matrix and negotiated schedule and fees are attached as backup.

Negotiations with Wharton-Smith, Inc. were successfully completed for Phase 1 of this project. This project will be delivered using the Progressive Design-Build method, splitting the efforts in two (2) phases. Phase 1 includes engineering design up to one hundred percent (100%), support services and preconstruction services, which is approximately 7.7% of the revised estimated project cost. Work under Phase 1 includes a pilot test operation to refine ion exchange system design parameters and capacity/sizing, optimizing blending ratio, and brine regeneration system. The resulting information will be used in the design and layout/configuration of the advanced treatment system under Phase 1. The Design-Builder (DB) has reviewed JEA's estimate for this project and after Phase 1, a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) will be established at 60% design, with an option of an "off ramp" if construction pricing is not acceptable. Upon acceptance of the GMP and subsequent approval of the Awards Committee, Phase 2 will commence. Phase 2 will include services during construction (SDC), construction costs and test & startup of the advanced treatment system.

Originally approved by Awards Committee on 09/21/2017 in the amount of \$42,000,000.00 to Williams Industrial Services LLC (\$14,000,000.00), Petticoat-Schmitt Civil Contractors Inc (\$14,000,000.00) and WPC Industrial Contractors LLC (\$14,000,000.00) as unit price contracts. A copy of the original award is attached as backup.

This contract increase request is to increase the contract caps of Williams Industrial and Petticoat-Schmitt. The third company originally awarded a contract (WPC Industrial) has been disbarred from bidding on JEA work for issues on another contract. Due to those issues, JEA stopped using WPC Industrial for this contract until those issues are resolved. This has caused the contracts of Williams Industrial and Petticoat-Schmitt to be used at a greater rate than originally anticipated. The proposed increases to Williams Industrial and Petticoat-Schmitt are forecast to fund the contracts through the term of the work. A listing of projects is attached as backup.

Work is awarded by two (2) methods, competitive lump sum bids between the companies for project work, which accounts for a larger portion of the total work, and direct award with time and material rates to the company best suited to perform specialized work. The contract labor rates are fixed for the first three (3) years of the contract, with a CPI price adjustment allowed in years four (4) and five (5). All other rates and markups are fixed for the five (5) year term.



- > Typically, a roadway improvement project being designed/constructed by another government agency, where
  - > JEA has identified a need to replace or improve existing facilities within the partnering agency's project limits (O&M, Planning)
  - $\succ$  The partner agencies' project has new facilities or construction methods that conflict with existing JEA facilities which require relocation per existing permit requirements
- Project examples resurfacing, drainage improvements, bridge construction, etc.
- > Not involved with Development projects where the developer has to modify JEA facilities to accommodate required roadway improvements
- Not involved in grant-funded projects from state/federal agencies

  - Blanket agreement; no agreement end date
- $\blacktriangleright$  Design by FDOT Contractor [Engineer] (Amend 1 4/14/11)
- Construction by FDOT Contractor
- No need to sign agreement every time funds are sent
- Engineers JEA negotiates scope/fee
- Construction send FDOT funds before bidding; after bidding
  - Add'l 10% contingency; Add'l 5% for administration
  - >\$300k goes through Awards Committee process

  - Extended to 12/31/22; Dollar limit to \$13,295,906
- Engineering and Construction
