Once the agreement is issued the collection system is to be pumped out via truck and the pump station shall not to be bypassed using a generator driven pump or a temporary line.

Service shall be available 24 hours/day and 7 days/week. Written logs of all pump-outs shall be made available upon request. If the system should overflow, the requestor assumes all liability and is responsible for notifying the appropriate environmental agencies, paying any regulatory penalties, and cleaning up as necessary. Also, once your contract with the contractor name above is terminated, the pump out agreement with JEA is also terminated.
