

JEA FOG Program Small Trap Maintenance Requirements at a Glance

- 1. All small traps smaller than 50 gallons must now be cleaned and inspected on a bi-weekly basis.**
 1. All prior issued variances and or agreements have been rescinded at this time.
 2. This maintenance should be completed in accordance with guidelines provided by JEA. Materials removed from the trap must be disposed of in a manner consistent with local solid waste requirements.

- 2. Person performing or supervising this cleaning should fill out the information required in the “Small Trap Maintenance Log.”**

Per Industrial Pretreatment Regulation this log must be retained onsite for a minimum of 3 years after the date of the final entry on the log.

- 3. Using information from the “Small Trap Maintenance Log” A facility manager must complete and mail pump out report card on a monthly basis.**

This card must be received by JEA no later than close of business on the 15th day of the month following the last date of cleaning.
