Background

JEA Power Pals is a school-based program designed to educate first-graders about electric safety best practices. But now, because of the COVID-19 pandemic, with so many children at home, we're putting this program online to help support our customers with small children, from kindergarten to second grade.

WORKSHEET 1: LIGHTING AND CORDS ANSWER KEY

Ask your child to identify the **10 electric dangers** that could be unsafe. Have them circle or place a sticker on the worksheet that identifies the danger.



WORKSHEET 2: ELECTRIC OUTLETS & APPLIANCES THAT GET HOT

Overview for Parents/Adult

Part 1 - Electric Outlets

Discuss safe behavior related to outlets - emphasize need for caution.

Instruct your child on the following:

- Tell an adult if they see too many cords plugged in to the same outlet
- If you want something unplugged or plugged, ask an adult
- When adults unplug a cord, they need to pull from the plug (not the cord)

Part 2 - Appliances that Get Hot





- Encourage students to identify electric appliances in your home and where they are located
- Discuss kinds of fire hazards related to space heaters and appliances and how to prevent them
- Emphasize importance of having a fire extinguisher in the home

WORKSHEET 3: WATER & ELECTRICITY DON'T MIX

Overview for Parents/Adult

Part 1 - Inside the Home

Liquids and electrical things never go together – either inside or outside the home.

Here are safety rules for inside the home:

- Never touch anything electrical with wet hands
- Don't let water get on anything with a plug
- Don't use electronic devices in or around water
- Keep drinks away from electrical outlets and devices like TVs, radios, computers, irons, etc.

Have your child complete 'Electricity & Water Do Not Mix' worksheets and share answers with you.




Part 2 - Outside the Home

Liquids and electrical things never go together.

- If there is lightning outside, make sure you and electrical things are inside
- If you see a downed power line, tell an adult immediately and stay far away from it
- Do not play on or near any areas that have signs posted saying 'Danger' High Voltage – 'KEEP OUT'
