This addendum is for the purpose of making the following additions, deletions and changes.

Supplier Inquiry: Is a Marine GC License required on the Bid Due Date? Can a Bidder be in progress of application at the Bid Due Date?

JEA Response: JEA has reviewed this request and is electing to remove the Marine GC License from the Qualification Requirements. The Marine experience in the Minimum Qualifications will remain.

The following Section 1.7 Minimum Qualifications to be assigned to the Qualified List replaces the section 1.7 issued with the original solicitation and addendum 1.

1.7 MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS TO BE ASSIGNED TO THE QUALIFIED LIST

The company shall meet the following minimum qualifications to be assigned to the Qualified List:

- The Bidder or their Subcontractor that will perform the Work will be required to have a Marine Construction Contractors License and a General Contractors License issued by the State of Florida.
- The Bidder or the Bidder's subcontractor shall have successfully performed as the prime contractor each of the following project types listed below in the past ten (10) years, date ending April 30, 2020. A Bidder or Prime Contractor using a subcontractor's experience (similar project) to meet the requirements listed below, shall use the subcontractor to perform the work in the Contract.
 - The Bidder or the Bidder's subcontractor shall have successfully completed, as the Prime Contractor, one (1) industrial structure demolition project with shall have included the following project elements:
 - A minimum of a \$500,000 project value
 - 50% of the project shall have been self-performed

Indicate if the Project Manager and Superintendent on the referenced project will also be assigned to this JEA project.

- The Bidder or the Bidder's subcontractor shall have successfully completed as the Prime Contractor, one (1) Marine construction or demolition project, which shall have included the following project elements:
 - wetlands impacts and restoration
 - the use of a barge mounted crane with a 50 ton capacity
 - A minimum \$500,000 project value
 - 50% of the project shall have been self-performed

Indicate if the Project Manager and Superintendent on the referenced project will also be assigned to this JEA project.

 The Bidder or the Bidder's subcontractor shall have successfully completed, as the Prime Contractor, one (1) similar project. A similar project is defined as work performed within proximity (< 25 ft) to an active rail line, which required the contractor obtain permits from CSXT and use CSXT-approved flagmen to execute the work with a minimum of a \$200,000 value. Indicate if the Project Manager and Superintendent on the referenced project will also be assigned to this JEA project.

Valid and up to date contact information must be provided for each project reference. Outdated or incorrect contact information may result in disqualification.

Please note, any Bidder whose Contract with JEA was terminated for default within the last two (2) years shall not be determined to be a responsible Bidder and their Bidder will be rejected.
