THIS ADDENDUM IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING THE FOLLOWING CHANGES OR CLARIFICATIONS:

1. JEA is responding the following questions:

Question:

How much money would you expect to spend on this project annually?

Answer:

The estimated contract value is \$9,000,000.00 over three years.

Question:

How big is the typical work order?

Answer:

The last 21 projects averaged approximately \$72,000.00 (including rehabilitation).

Question:

How often would a work order be issued?

Answer:

We have a project review meeting every two weeks, and we release jobs as they are identified.

Acknowledge receipt of this Addendum on the Proposal Form (Appendix B)

Question:

The specs state the proposer shall have completed 100,000'. Can the subcontractor have the experience to meet this qualification or must it be the prime contractor?

Answer:

It must be the prime.

Question:

Will JEA accept a general contractor's license in lieu underground utility?

Answer:

Underground Utility license is required.

Question:

What is the engineer's budget for this contract?

Answer:

Budget – 3 years, \$9,000,000 total

Question:

Lastly, can we be supplied with a year of invoices for similar work, or a summary of what has been used in the past. This information can supply the bidders with a general idea of what the needs may be by the JEA.

Answer:

For the previous 12 months, future quantities and details will vary:
Pipeburst 18,411 linear feet, ranging between 6" (409 lf) and 10" (1205 lf) with the balance being 8". Typically VC, with some DI and CI. Spend \$2.95M, all in cost including site rehab.

Question:

Could we please be provided with the bid tabulations for the previous version of the contract?
If this is a new contract, then what the prices being charged for similar work to the JEA.
