THIS ADDENDUM IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING THE FOLLOWING CHANGES OR CLARIFICATIONS:

1. Question: The solicitation mentions that the pre-proposal meeting is optional, but the next sentence indicates that proposers NOT attending the Pre-Proposal meeting may have their Proposals rejected and returned unopened. This is a little confusing. Are we required to attend the Pre-Proposal meeting?

Answer: No, we can offer to meet on site on a specified date and time.

2. Question: Item 1.12 indicates that in order to submit a proposal, an interested Company must go to:

http://www.jea.com/About/Procurement/Formal_Procurement_Opportunities/ and click on the "Request a Submission Link" for the solicitation number 099-20. This submission does not exist on the link. When should we expect it to be updated?

Answer: Kindly try the link again. We tested it and were able to access the request a Submission link. When you click on it an email will route to bids@jea.com where you can request a link.

3. Appendix A: Scope of Work, Page 4 of 8 – First sentence indicates District II Water Reclamation Facility New Warehouse and Site Improvements. We assume this is a typo? Please confirm.

Answer: Substitute District II for Fleet Services.

4. Appendix A: Please confirm that no site related/civil upgrades (hardscape of landscape) are required as a part of this project scope.

Answer: None required. All work internal.

5. Appendix A: The cost estimate indicates an Add Alternate for a Bridge Crane. The scope of work does not indicate a bridge crane as an alternate or one might go. We assume this is a typo? Please confirm.

Answer: Delete Alt One.

6. Please confirm if Fire Protection/sprinkler for the mezzanine level mass storage area was a consideration during the development of the technical documents and cost estimate.

Answer: 10% concept is basic layout design concept. Design must include all systems required to meet State Building Codes.
