THIS ADDENDUM IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING THE FOLLOWING CHANGES OR CLARIFICATIONS:

1. **Change:** The Bid Due Date has been extended to **October 28, 2025**.
2. **Question:** It looks like the manholes are staked very near or in the drainage ditch. Can you confirm that is correct? Is there any specific plan to allow drainage around the manholes, or will these manholes be flush with the grade in the drainage ditch?

Answer: JEA will evaluate at each location but the intent is to have the manhole lids in the side of the ditch as flush as possible. Some small rerouting of the ditch might be necessary.

3. **Question:** Will each manhole to manhole run of conduit be 2 drills with 2 conduits in each drill or can the 4 conduits be pulled back in 1 drill?

Answer: See Addendum 2.

4. **Question:** As required in the Norfolk Southern Railroad Approved Application document, will the 6" SDR 11 be provided by JEA?

Answer: Yes

5. **Question:** Due to the work hour restrictions associated with the MOT, are the liquidated damages to be levied in the event the 4-month timeline cannot be met?

Answer: No

6. **Question:** Can material and equipment be stored in the ROW during the manhole installation process, or must all equipment be returned to the laydown area at the end of each working day?

Answer: Due to the limited space in the ROW, leaving material and equipment along the road may become a safety hazard for customers entering or leaving their driveway. This can be discussed with the inspector on a per location basis.

7. **Question:** In the document titled 'Manhole Exploratory Excavates', what do the (2-3) cables labeled 'Black Cable' represent? In the event these lines are fiber, may they be safely adjusted during the construction process to clear additional room for excavating if needed?

Answer: JEA cannot authorize the repositioning or handling of other utilities.

8. **Question:** The solicitation states that if the respondent plans to use subcontractors for more than 50% of the work, JEA must be notified. Can you please confirm the relevance of that clause to this solicitation.

Answer: JEA understands that this scope may require more than 50% use of subcontractors due to the nature of scope. Please list your subcontractors and percentages on the List of Subcontractors form to be submitted with your response. It will be at JEA's sole discretion to approve the subcontractors listed.
