THIS ADDENDUM IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING THE FOLLOWING CHANGES OR CLARIFICATIONS:

- 1) **Question:** In Appendix A – Technical Specifications on page 4 of the RFP 1412156846, the City of Lake Worth Beach Electric Utilities (FMPPA) is not listed in the example of utilities in the SERC region. Will JEA accept projects performed for this specific electric utility?

Answer: Yes, JEA will accept projects for City of Lake Worth Beach Electric Utilities (FMPPA).

- 2) **Question:** We would like to request an extension to the proposal due date of one week.

Answer: At this time, JEA will not grant an extension.

- 3) **Question:** For the required JEA reference project, may respondents list a JEA employee who is directly involved in this solicitation?

Answer: Yes. The requirement to provide a JEA project applies only to the Minimum Qualifications section. If a company has performed similar work for JEA within the past two years, it must list JEA as a reference to satisfy the minimum qualifications requirement. Respondents are not required to include a JEA project under the Company Experience evaluation criteria portion of the solicitation.

A JEA reference contact may also serve as an evaluator for this solicitation. However, all evaluations will be conducted independently and without communication among evaluators, except in a publicly noticed setting in accordance with the solicitation process.

- 4) **Question:** Section 1.10 requires Respondents to provide three (3) qualifying projects on the Appendix B Minimum Qualification Form. Section 1.18 also requests three (3) similar projects within the Company Experience section. Does JEA want the same three (3) projects submitted in Appendix B form also be included in the Company Experience section, or does JEA expect different project examples to be provided for each section?

Answer: The response to Question 3 addressed this in part; however, to clarify, the similar projects listed on Appendix B – Bid Form are required solely for the purpose of demonstrating compliance with the Minimum Qualifications. The projects submitted under the Company Experience evaluation criteria may be different projects at the respondent's discretion.

- 5) **Question:** Section 1.10 states that "Respondents that are working or have worked for JEA in the past 2 years involving similar work must submit JEA as a reference." If a Respondent is currently performing or has recently performed services for JEA that are not directly related to protection and controls engineering, should JEA still be

included as a reference, or is this requirement intended only for projects involving similar protection and control scope?

Answer: Respondents should list JEA as a reference for any engineering work performed for JEA within the past two years. If the Lead Evaluator determines that the referenced project scope is not sufficiently similar to the requirements of this solicitation, JEA may request additional project references to verify compliance with the Minimum Qualifications.

- 6) **Question:** Appendix A – Technical Specifications references qualifying project experience with utilities located within the SERC Reliability Corporation region. For certain qualifying projects of ours, contractual confidentiality provisions restrict disclosure of the client name, contact information, and/or project cost. Will JEA accept project experience descriptions that discuss the relevant scope of work, technical services provided, and project characteristics without identifying the client name or confidential project details?

Answer: Respondents may elect to provide a reference as described in the question. However, if JEA determines that the information provided is insufficient to adequately evaluate the reference, JEA may request additional project references or evaluate the submission accordingly based on the information provided.

- 7) **Question:** Are the Protection & Controls Engineer 1, 2 and 3 positions identified in the solicitation, based on levels / years of experience / classification, or is it meant to just identify three separate Protections and Controls Engineer positions?

Answer: It is meant to identify levels of experience and classification.
