
Scope of Work:

All units must have updated DOT inspection/service, rebuild, and di-electric test documentation, have been tested and delivered to JEA Fleet Facility (5717 New Kings Road Jacksonville, Florida 32209) in complete operational condition.

PRIMARY: Seven years and newer model year production Category C AERIAL UNITS / CAB CHASSIS with all up-dated DOT Inspection/Service, Rebuild and DI-Electric Test Documentation. Reference: In-Service JEA UNITS for additional details and clarification.

SECONDARY: All available model year production Category C AERIAL UNITS / CAB CHASSIS with all up-dated DOT Inspection/Service,, Rebuild and DI-Electric Test Documentation. Reference: In-Service JEA UNITS for additional details and clarification.

- 1. Typical aerial equipment covered under this partnership will be as follows:
 - 1.1. Category C 37' to 40' ONE MAN Squirt Booms: Example Altec AT-40G or Equal



1.2. Category C 37' to 40' TWO MAN Squirt Booms: Example Altec TA-40 or Equal



1.3. Category C 55' to 60' TWO MAN Bucket Trucks: Example Altec AA-55E or Equal



1.4. Category C 55' to 60' TWO MAN / MATERIAL HANDLER Bucket Trucks: Example Altec AA-55E with 2000 LB Capacity JIB or Equal



1.5. Category C 45' to 50' Derrick Digger (18" AUGER): Example Altec DM47, Altec DH50 or Equal



- 2. The agency shall be responsible, 24/7 support for all maintenance activities including Preventative Maintenance (PM) during the contract term including during times of activation. All dedicated generators will be load tested prior to June 1st with monthly PMs performed during the six (6) month storm season period, and when they are deployed.
- 3. JEA shall have exclusive use of the assets for internal use, or for deployment under a mutual aid agreement with other utilities.
- 4. Fuel management for aerial equipment assets, while in active use, shall be supplied and managed by JEA. Provider shall be responsible for fuel during storage of assets.
