Add (1): JEA adds the following questions and answers to this Solicitation.

## Supplier Inquiry 1):

Is the purpose of this tool solely for Public Records Requests or might this expand into E-Discovery(for-litigation/subpoenas)? JEA Response: Our department will primarily use this tool for public records requests. We also respond to subpoenas and assist with discovery.

## Supplier Inquiry 2):

Does JEA have a current system in place for receiving, tracking, and responding to Public Records Requests? Would they like this solution to tie into that tool?
JEA Response: We have a "home-grown" tracking system. We are not asking for the solution to integrate or tie in with that system.

## Supplier Inquiry 3):

Would JEA be interested in a tool that not only handled the collection from Exchange but also managed the workflow and notifications within and between departments?
JEA Response: A tool integrating with Exchange is a "nice to have," requirement. A workflow and notifications tool within and between departments is outside the scope of this solicitation.

## Supplier Inquiry 4):
