- 2. Would you be willing to provide a moffett truck for Water and Wastewater material deliveries if JEA guaranteed you to be paid a monthly rate as long as you were in good standing (JEA would terminate payment if the agreement was terminated for cause)?
- 3. Would you be willing to provide a moffett truck for Water and Wastewater material deliveries if JEA DID NOT guarantee you to be paid, and you were only paid on a per delivery basis when the moffett delivery was requested?
- 4. Would you be willing to provide a moffett truck for Water and Wastewater material deliveries if JEA DID NOT guarantee you to be paid for the costs of the truck, but instead the costs were spread out across all items based on JEA's estimated usage?
