NOTIFICATION PROCEDURE FOR POTENTIAL PROBLEMS TO THE SANITARY SEWER

In the event of any discharge that may adversely impact the Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW), the User shall notify JEA according to the following procedure. Such discharges may include, but not be limited to: accidental discharges; discharges of a non-routine, episodic nature; non-customary batch discharges; slug loads; pretreatment system upsets; pretreatment system bypasses; slug loads; or spills to the sanitary sewer system. "Upset" means an exceptional incident in which there is unintentional and temporary noncompliance with categorical pretreatment standards because of factors beyond the reasonable control of the industrial user, as defined in 62-625.200(23), F.A.C. Such notification is required by §7.6 of the JEA *Industrial Pretreatment Regulation*.

1. VERBAL NOTIFICATION

Verbal notification shall be made immediately by the fastest means of communication available (generally by telephone) to your compliance officer or one of the following personnel. Notification shall include the location of the discharge; date and time thereof; type of waste, concentration and volume of the waste; and corrective actions taken.

2. WRITTEN NOTIFICATION

Within five (5) days following an accidental discharge, the permittee shall submit a detailed written report describing the cause(s) of the discharge and the measures to be taken to prevent similar future occurrences. The report shall be submitted to:
