initiatives, envi	Effect: The July 2013 Board meeting included a presentation which summarized Septic Tank Phase-out initiatives, environmental impacts, and the economic scale of septic tank issues. The economic considerations and challenges of converting private water supply wells to a public water distribution system are similar to the septic tank phase-out issues.						
Cost or Benefit: The cost of a private property owner to convert from a private water supply well to the centralized JEA water system typically exceeds \$5,000. Aligned with industry standards, JEA's rate structure is designed such that the initial capital infrastructure cost is paid by the property owner.							
Recommended Board action: Although no Board action is required, JEA has performed design and management functions to develop water supply alternatives in areas with failed private wells, and continues to work with City Council members and others who are seeking funding sources. This presentation is provided for information.
