- 4. Request approval to purchase seven (7) JEA Class 212C Truck 3T, Bucket 40' (Cut in Truck) from Altec Industries, Inc. by piggy back of GSA Contract #GS-30F-1028G. Unit price \$167,655.00 each for a total amount of \$1,173,585.00, subject to lawfully appropriated funds.
