The average project manager rate is \$158.75/hr and the average support role rate is \$113/hr. The rates submitted by Burns & McDonnell are forty two percent (42%) higher on average. The previous contracts in which these rates were compared were with smaller firms and JEA expects Burns & McDonnell a larger firm to produce quality work with less hours required. The proposed rates contained in the this Burns & McDonnell award are the same rates previously awarded to Burns & McDonnell for general engineering services by the awards committee on $03/21/2024$ and for substation/ transmission general engineering services on $5/23/2024$.
