THIS ADDENDUM IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING THE FOLLOWING CHANGES OR CLARIFICATIONS:

1. Section 1.5.14 SUBCONTRACTORS of the solicitation has been adjusted to the following language.

The Respondent must list the names of the major Subcontractors that it intends to use for this Work, unless the Work will be self-performed by the Respondent. The Subcontractors must be listed on the Subcontractors Form which is available at jea.com. The winning bidder must submit the List of subcontractors form referenced in Section 1.2.4 prior to execution of a Contract. The Respondent shall not use Subcontractors other than those shown on the Subcontractor Form unless it shows good cause and obtains the JEA Representative's prior written consent.

2. A supplier asked, "The layout includes groups with single units to bid and multiple units to bid. If there are multiple line items contained in a specific group and we cannot meet the specifications of all line items included, can we still bid on the units where we do meet specification? I am unclear if the groups are inclusive to bid all or lose the opportunity if each unit's specifications can be met."

The groups are all inclusive of each other for award purposes.

3. A supplier asked, "Could the stakebody/liftgate be categorized into it's own Group? If the groups could be modified to add an 8th option then we can participate."

At this time, JEA will not be adjusting the stakebody/liftgate into in own group and the sole unit will remain in Grouping number 5.

4. A supplier asked, "If we don't meet all the minimum technical requirements as called out in your technical specification, are we still eligible for award?"

Suppliers must ensure that what you are bidding meets the minimum qualifications of this bid as well as the listed technical specifications as described within the Appendix A – Technical Specifications.

If there are aspects of the technical specification you have concerns about, these must be addressed and a JEA response no later than 5 days before the bid due date. We cannot accept a bid where your bid does not meet the minimum qualifications of this bid and/or technical specifications as described within the Appendix A – Technical Specifications.
